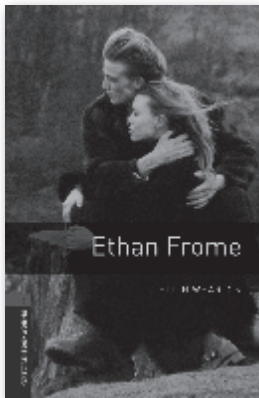

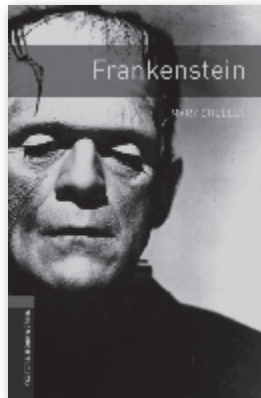
## Ethan Frome

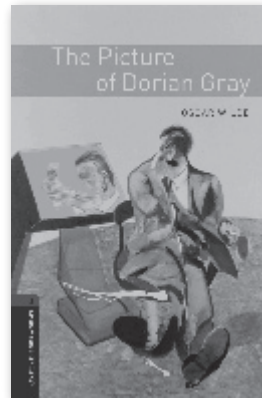

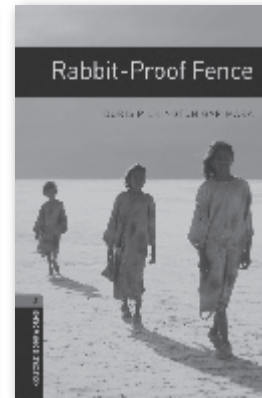

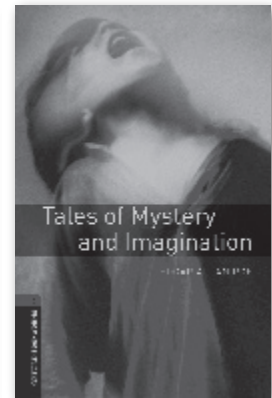
