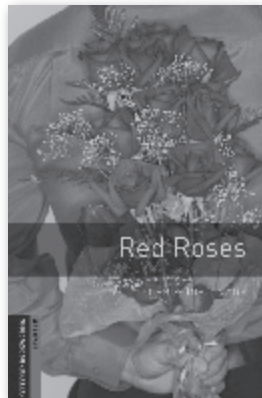

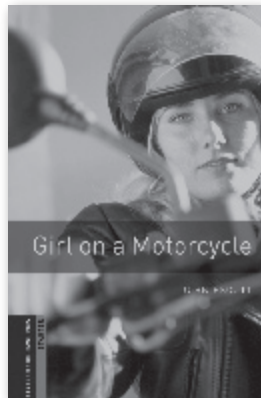
### Red Roses

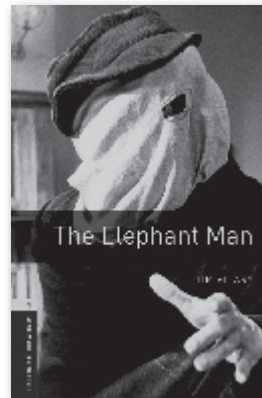

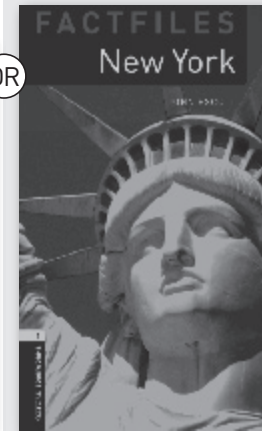
